Lesson Stress/Explanation

Prop Idea boot photograph	1	Learn to draw a mountain boot.
	2	Learn to use a more illustrative drawing style.
	3	Practice proper marker coloring technique.

Supplies **Drawing**

X	PENCILS	The boot is presented from a side view. It is VERY LARGE and fills the page. The initial foot shape is BIG and nearly fills the lower half. The ankle is WIDE and dictates the thickness of the leg. The boot is divided into sections. Each section is decorated with details, patterns, and textures. Keep these details manageable and be sure they are drawn large enough to accommodate marker coloring. Stress clean, legible line work.

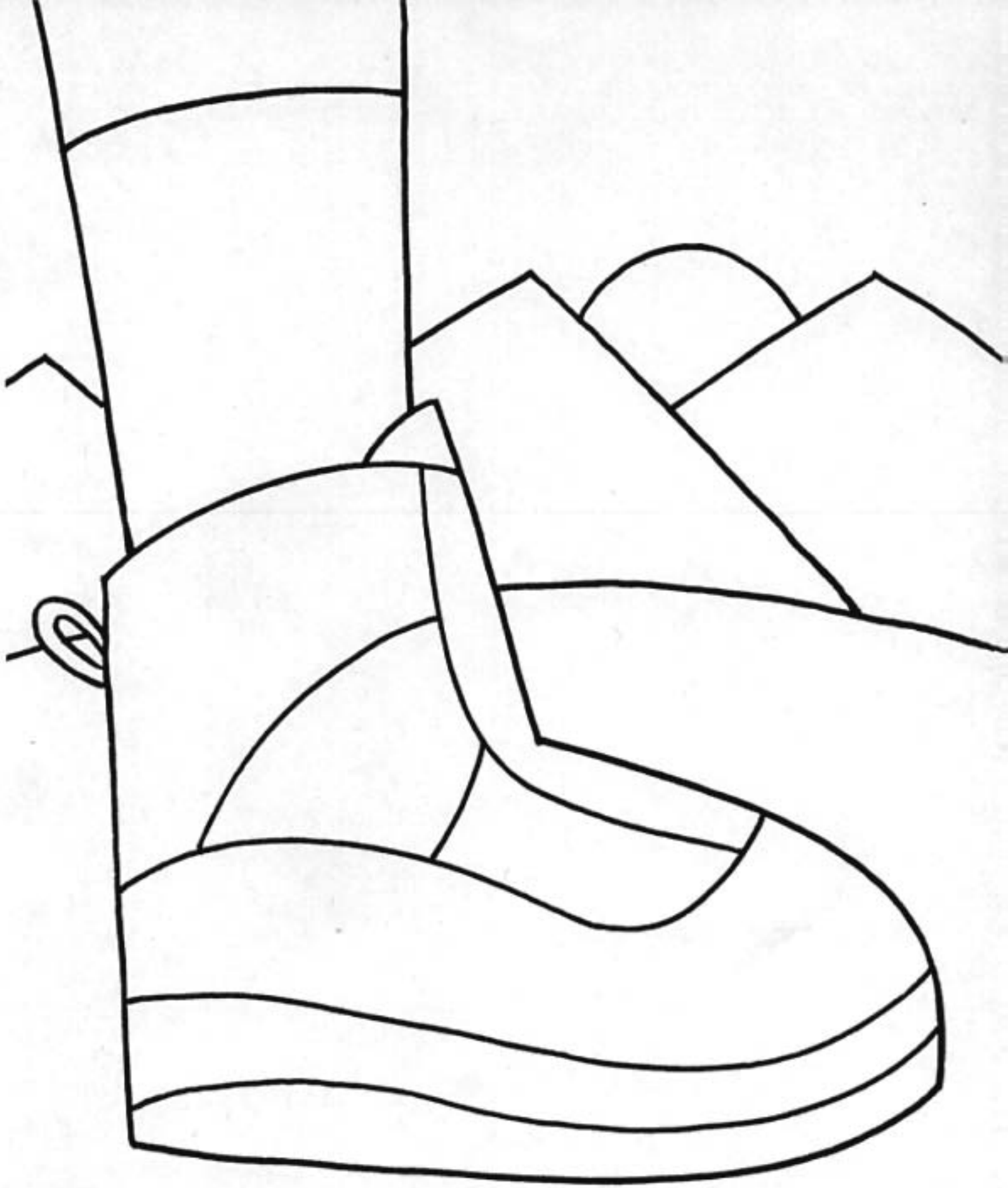

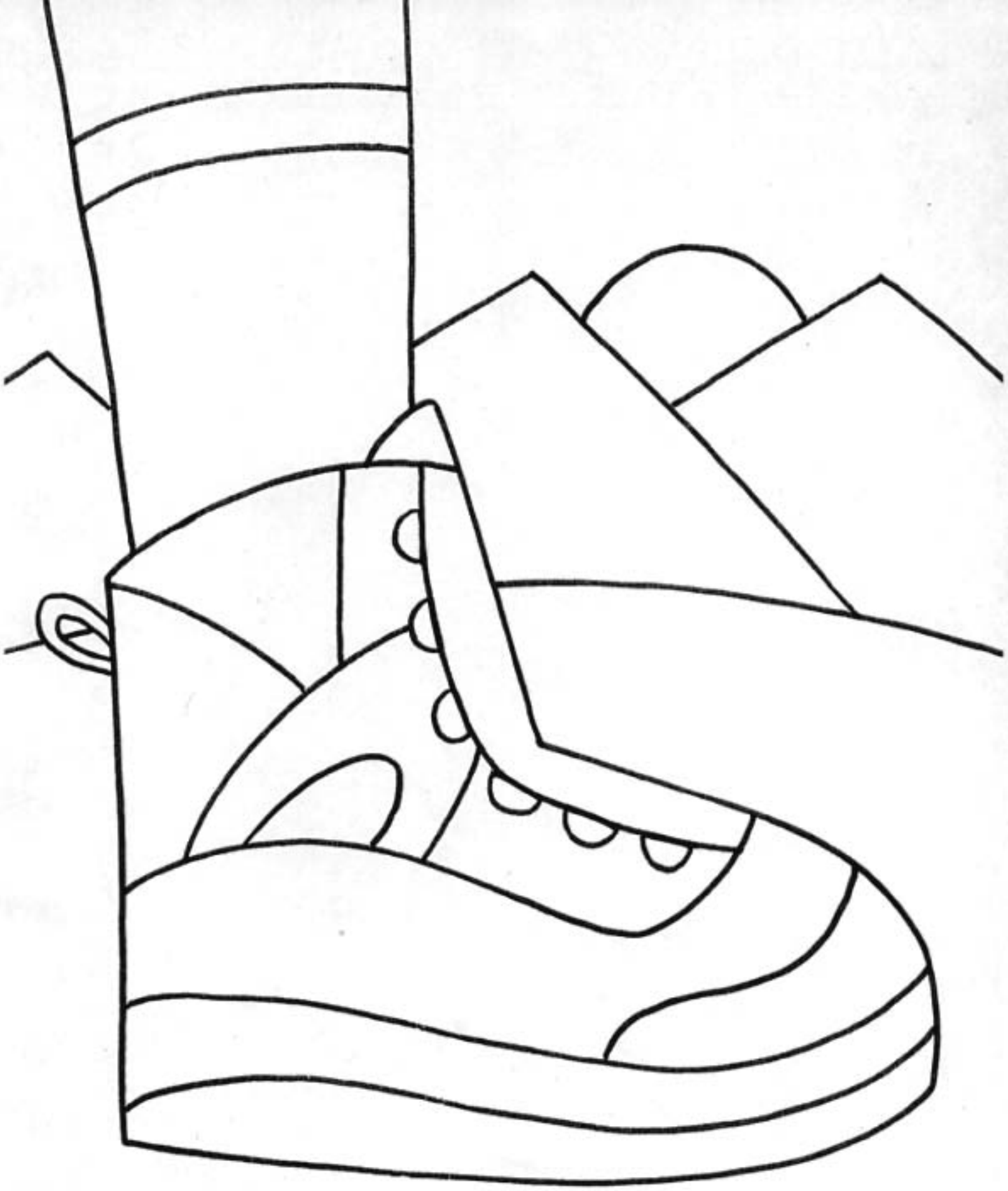

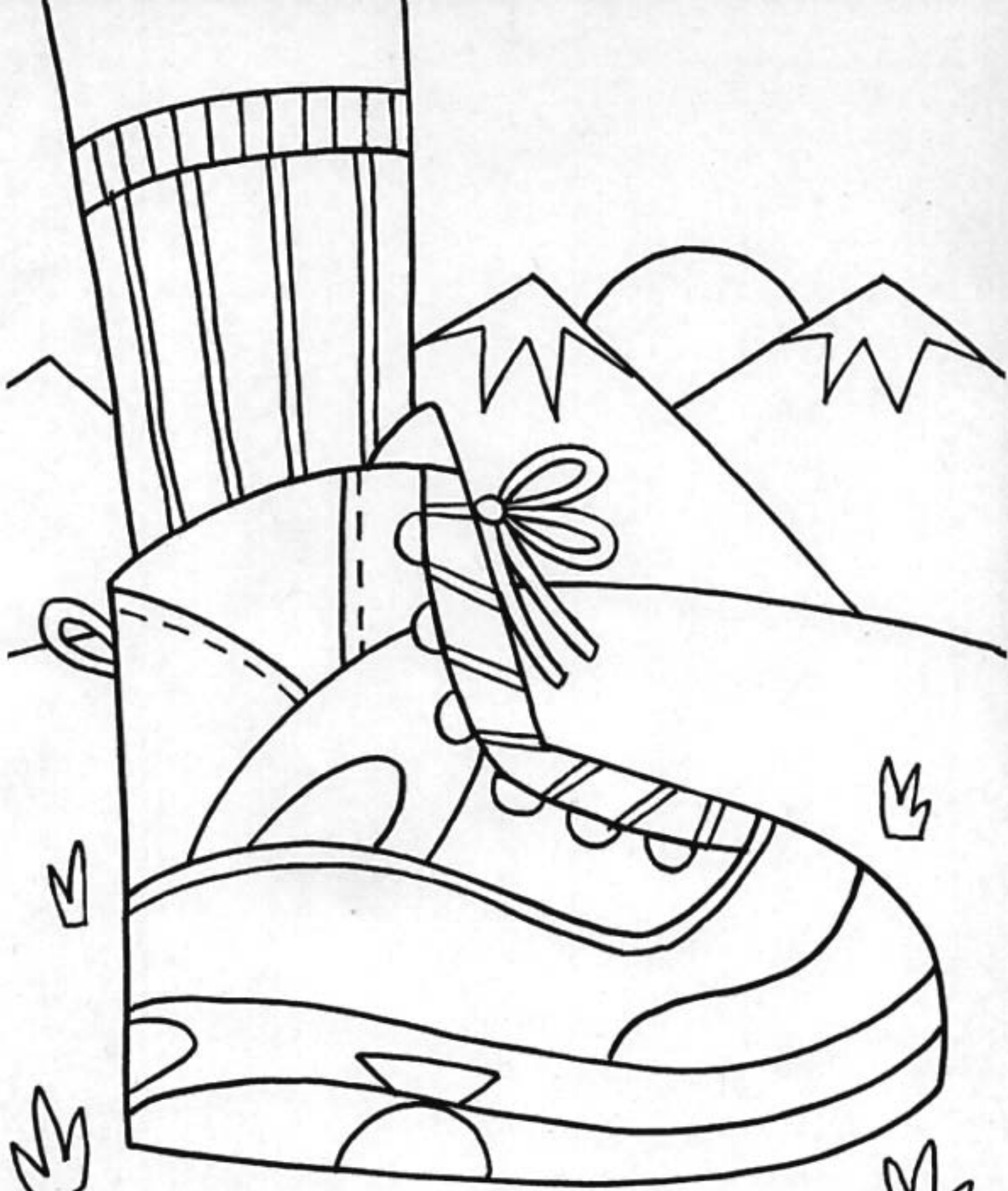
